- ALL COMPETITIONS are run under ESNZ, RAS, and Wairoa A&P Society local show rules. All entries are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Society which are deemed to be included herein, as if inserted at length.
- **HEALTH & SAFETY AT WORK ACT 2015**  
The Wairoa A&P Society is required to conform to the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015. However, as a Show Participant at this venue, you are also obligated to accept responsibilities in relation to the operation and use of our "Place of Employment" within the focus of this Act which is to **Eliminate or Substitute. Minimise by Isolation, Engineering Control, Administration Control, Personal Protective Equipment Clothing** to Personal Health and Safety.  
The Wairoa A&P Society is responsible to present a safe venue for use.

1 cup plain flour, 1 tspn baking powder, ½ t cinnamon – Sift dry ingredients & add to creamed mixture with 1.5 cups rolled oats.

Stir well. Roll tablespoons full of mixture into balls. Place on a greased oven tray. Flatten and bake at 180C for 15 minutes or until golden brown.
