- All Exhibits must be the Bona fide/original work of the exhibitor, and must be home grown/homemade.
- **Late entries not accepted** as we will be straight into staging and judging.

125g butter, ½ cup sugar, 2 Tbspn honey – Cream butter sugar & honey together until pale.

1 cup plain flour, 1 tspn baking powder, ½ t cinnamon – Sift dry ingredients & add to creamed mixture with 1.5 cups rolled oats.

Stir well. Roll tablespoons full of mixture into balls. Place on a greased oven tray. Flatten and bake at 180C for 15 minutes or until golden brown.
